1 WHEREAS, on February 23, 2024, plaintiff David Neilsen commenced the 2 above-captioned action by filing a securities class action complaint on behalf of a 3 purported class of investors in Lantronix, Inc. ("Lantronix") securities;

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Neilsen's complaint asserted claims under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 ("Exchange Act");

6 WHEREAS, on April 23, 2024, Robert Ratliff moved this Court for appointment as lead plaintiff and approval of his selection of counsel, claiming losses in connection with his purchases of Lantronix securities of \$8,230.26 under the Exchange Act (see ECF 24-2);

- 10 WHEREAS, on April 23, 2024, Hana Touati moved this Court for 11 appointment as lead plaintiff and approval of her selection of counsel, claiming 12 losses in connection with her purchases of Lantronix securities of \$13,193 under 13 the Exchange Act (see ECF 28-1);
- 14 WHEREAS, the Private Securities Litigation Reform Act of 1995 15 ("PSLRA"), 15 U.S.C. §78u-4(a)(3)(B)(iii), provides, inter alia, that the most 16 adequate plaintiff to serve as lead plaintiff is, in the determination of the Court, the 17 "person or group of persons" that has the largest financial interest in the relief 18 sought by the class and otherwise satisfies the relevant requirements of Rule 23 of 19 the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure;

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Ratliff and Ms. Touati have provided signed, sworn 21 Certifications in support of their motions for appointment as lead plaintiff setting 22 forth, *inter alia*, their transactions in Lantronix securities;

WHEREAS, 15 U.S.C. §78u-4(a)(3)(B)(v) provides that, subject to the approval of the Court, the most adequate plaintiff will select and retain counsel to 25 represent the class, and Mr. Ratliff has selected and retained the law firm of Levi & 26 Korsinsky, LLP ("Levi & Korsinsky"), and Ms. Touati has selected and retained 27 the law firm of Pomerantz LLP ("Pomerantz"), to pursue this litigation on behalf of 28 the class if they are appointed lead plaintiff;

WHEREAS, after reviewing each other's submissions to the Court, Mr. 1 Ratliff and Ms. Touati – as the only movants in contention for appointment as lead 2 plaintiff and as a combination of individuals with the largest financial interests in 3 the relief sought by the class, with Mr. Ratliff claiming losses as a result of 4 purchases of Lantronix securities on November 10, 2023 and Ms. Touati claiming 5 losses as a result of purchases of Lantronix securities on February 8, 2024 - met 6 7 and conferred and agreed to resolve their competing motions and to seek, with the Court's approval, to serve jointly as lead plaintiff and for their selection of counsel, 8 the law firms of Levi & Korsinsky and Pomerantz, to serve as lead counsel; 9

WHEREAS, courts within the Ninth Circuit have endorsed stipulations 10 among competing lead plaintiff movants as promoting the statutory purposes of the 11 12 PSLRA, and have permitted independent lead plaintiff movants to join together where movants "concluded that a protracted dispute concerning lead plaintiff 13 appointment . . . [was] not in the best interests of the class and that jointly 14 15 prosecuting [the] litigation would be appropriate and assist with the speedy commencement of [the] litigation." In re Facebook, Inc. Sec. Litig., No. 5:18-cv-16 01725-EJD, ECF 56 at 2-3 (N.D. Cal. Aug. 3, 2018) (approving stipulation of lead 17 plaintiff movants); Petersen v. Stem, Inc., et al., No. 3:23-cv-02329-MMC, ECF 72 18 (N.D. Cal. Aug. 22, 2023) (appointing co-lead plaintiffs and co-lead counsel 19 pursuant to proposed so-ordered stipulation); *Pizzuto v. Homology Meds., Inc.*, No. 20 2:22-cv-01968-FLA-JPR, ECF 38 (C.D. Cal. July 1, 2022) (same); Terenzini v. 21 GoodRx Holdings, Inc., No. 2:20-cv-11444-DOC-PD, ECF 65 (C.D. Cal. Apr. 8, 22 2021) (same); Zhou v. Faraday Future Intelligent Elec. Inc. f/k/a Prop. Sols. 23 Acquisition Corp., No. 2:21-cv-09914-CAS-JC, ECF 32-33 (C.D. Cal. Mar. 7, 24 2022) (same); 25
